## Mental health impacts every area of their lives




2 in 5

seniors with a chronic condition say they are concerned about maintaining their mental health.


#### Treatment costs are a rising concern

METHODOLOGY: This poll was conducted between May 6-May 7, 2022 among a sample of 1,000 seniors. The interviews were conducted online and the data were weighted by gender, age, race/ethnicity, education level, and region. Results from the full survey have a margin of error of plus or minus 3 percentage points. A subsample of 222 seniors on

Medicare with at least one chronic condition is also examined in this survey. The subsample data are unweighted and results have a margin of error of plus or minus 7 percentage points. An original poll was conducted between April 22-May 4, 2021 among a sample of 1,000 seniors on Medicare with chronic conditions. The interviews were conducted online and the data unweighted. Results from the full survey

have a margin of error of plus or minus 3 percentage points. Data from the 2021 poll is compared to the 2022 unweighted subsample of seniors on Medicare with at least one chronic condition for trending purposes.
